This light weight hat is pure joy to knit and wear. The cashmere is truly decadent to work with and knits up fast.

## MATERIALS \& INFO

Yarn: 1 skein Yarn Twisters Berkley; 210 yards/50g; 100\% Cashmere; approx. 40 g used for sample

Sample knit in colourway Salty Dog
Gauge: 30 sts by 44 Rnds equal 4" by 4 " in stockinette in the round before blocking

Needles: 2.75 mm (US 2) 16" circular needle; or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions: stitch marker, darning needle
Finished size unstretched: Circumference 14"; Height 8"

## ABBREVIATIONS

BOR - beginning of Rnd
CO-cast on
k - knit
k2tog - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2 sts, knit the 2 sts together as one ( 1 st decreased)
pm - place marker
Rnd - round
st/sts - stitch/stitches

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

CO 130 sts, join to knit in the Rnd, careful to not twist your sts, pm to denote the beginning of the Rnd

## Ribbing

k3, p2 rib for approximately 2 inches

## Body

Rnd 1: k
Repeat Rnd 1 until hat measures 7 " from the CO edge

## Decreases

Rnd 1: *k8, k2tog*, repeat ** to end of Rnd (117 sts)
Rnd 2 and every other even Rnd: $k$
Rnd 3: *k7, k2tog*, repeat ** to end of Rnd (104 sts)
Rnd 5: *k6, k2tog*, repeat ** to end of Rnd (91 sts)
Rnd 7: *k5, k2tog*, repeat ** to end of Rnd (78 sts)
Rnd 9: *k4, k2tog*, repeat ** to end of Rnd (65 sts)

Rnd 11: *k3, k2tog*, repeat ** to end of Rnd (52 sts)
Rnd 13: *k2, k2tog*, repeat ** to end of Rnd (39 sts)
Rnd 15: *k1, k2tog*, repeat ** to end of Rnd (26 sts)
Rnd 17: *k2tog*, repeat ** to end of Rnd (13 sts)
Finishing
Cut yarn, leaving a 6 " tail, thread through remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole, weave in ends
