MATERIALS & INFO	ABBREVIATIONS
Yarn: 1 skein Yarn Twisters Berkley; 210 yards/50g;	BOR - beginning of Rnd
100% Cashmere; approx. 40g used for sample	CO - cast on
Sample knit in colourway Salty Dog	k - knit
Gauge: 30 sts by 44 Rnds equal 4" by 4" in	
stockinette in the round before blocking	<b>k2tog</b> - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2 sts,
Needles: 2.75 mm (US 2) 16" circular needle; or size	knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)
needed to obtain gauge	pm – place marker
Notions: stitch marker, darning needle	Rnd - round
Finished size unstretched: Circumference 14"; Height 8"	<b>st/sts</b> - stitch/stitches

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

CO 130 sts, join to knit in the Rnd, careful to not twist your sts, pm to denote the beginning of the Rnd

### Ribbing

k3, p2 rib for approximately 2 inches

#### Body

Rnd 1: k

Repeat Rnd 1 until hat measures 7" from the CO edge

### Decreases

Rnd 1: \*k8, k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (117 sts)

# Rnd 2 and every other even Rnd: $\boldsymbol{k}$

**Rnd 3:** \*k7, k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (104 sts)

Rnd 5: \*k6, k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (91 sts)

**Rnd 7:** \*k5, k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (78 sts)

Rnd 9: \*k4, k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (65 sts)

 Rnd 11: \*k3, k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (52 sts)

 Rnd 13: \*k2, k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (39 sts)

 Rnd 15: \*k1, k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (26 sts)

 Rnd 17: \*k2tog\*, repeat \*\* to end of Rnd (13 sts)

#### Finishing

Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail, thread through remaining sts and pull tight to close the hole, weave in ends
