



YARN TWISTERS

Buttoned Basketweave Cowl

Easy learn to knit pattern. Once complete you will have learned how to cast on, the knit stitch, the purl stitch, one row buttonhole, and to cast off.



MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: 1 ball Drop Andes; 98 yards/100 grams, 65% wool, 35% alpaca OR 1 skein of Estelle Chunky; 136 yards/100 grams, 50% acrylic, 40% wool, 10% nylon

Gauge: 10 sts x 14 rows equals 4" by 4" in stockinette

Needles: 9mm (US 13) needles

Notions: darning needle, two 7/8" buttons

Finished size: 21" (53cm) x 8" (20cm)

Note:

Use tables to check off rows when complete

ABBREVIATIONS

BO - bind off

CO - cast on

k - knit

k2tog - knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

p - purl

st/sts - stitch/stitches

yo - yarnover (1 st increased), bring yarn in front of work, bring yarn over the right hand needle

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Using the long tail cast on method, CO 21 sts

Knit 10 rows

Begin basket weave pattern:

Row 1: k8, p5, k8

Row 2: k3, p5, k5, p5, k3

Row 3: as Row 1

Row 4: as Row 2

Row 5: as Row 1

Repeat **Rows 1 to 5** thirteen more times (total of 14 repeats)

Knit 5 rows

Button hole row - k6, yo, k2tog, k5, k2tog, yo, k6

Knit 4 rows

Loosely BO all sts, cut yarn, weave in ends

Sew buttons on the CO end of cowl to align with buttonholes

Wear and enjoy!
