



# YARN TWISTERS

Giddy Up  
created by Lisa Overby



A simple triangle kerchief knit in our Berkley Base, a 100% Cashmere yarn that is delightful to wear.



## MATERIALS & INFO

**Yarn:** 1 skein Yarn Twisters Berkley; 210 yards/50g; 100% Cashmere OR any fingering weight yarn

Sample knit in colourway Cherry

**Gauge:** 20 sts by 24 rows equals 4" by 4" in 6 Row pattern repeat before blocking

**Needles:** 3.5 mm (US 4) needle; or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** removable stitch marker (optional to mark the right side of the work), darning needle

**Finished size:** Centre Depth: 13" (33cm); Wingspan: 41" (104cm)

## ABBREVIATIONS

**BO** - bind off

**CO** - cast on

**k** - knit

**kfb** - knit front back; knit into the front of the stitch, leaving on the left-hand needle, knit into the back of the same stitch, dropping the stitch off the left-hand needle (1 stitch increased)

**k2tog** - knit 2 together; insert needle into the next 2 sts, knit the 2 sts together as one (1 st decreased)

**RHN** - right hand needle

**sl** - slip

**st/sts** - stitch/stitches

**wyif** - with yarn if front

**yo** - yarnover (1 st increased)

## PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

CO 3 sts

### Set Up

**Row 1:** kfb, kfb, sl1 wyif (5 sts)

**Row 2:** k to last st, sl1 wyif

**Row 3:** kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, sl1 wyif (7 sts)

**Row 4:** as Row 2

**Rows 5 to 8:** repeat Rows 3 and 4 **two** more times (11 sts)

### Main Pattern

**Row 1:** kfb, \*k2tog, yo \*, repeat \*\* to last 2 sts, kfb, sl1 wyif (2 sts increased)

**Row 2:** k to last st, sl1 wyif

**Row 3:** kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, sl1 wyif (2 sts increased)

**Row 4:** as Row 2

**Row 5:** as Row 3 (2 sts increased)

**Row 6:** as Row 2

**Rows 7 to 126:** repeat Rows 1 to 6 **twenty** more times (137 sts)

BO all sts using a stretchy bind off method of your choice

The sample uses the yarn over bind off method (see link to picture tutorial in notes):

k2, \*pass the second st over the first st on the RHN (same as a normal BO), yo, pass the new second st over the yo just created, k1\*

Repeat \*\* until you have 2 sts remaining, pass the second st of the first st on the RHN, cut yarn, pull up through st; weave in your ends and block piece to measurements
