

THE OJIBWAY CLUB TENNIS and PICKLE BALL POLICY 2022

General

Ojibway Tennis is an important aspect of the Ojibway Club. It operates on a budget that is dependent upon tennis and pickle ball membership fees and programs revenues. Court maintenance and improvements are financed from tennis revenues. Playing privileges are extended to Ojibway Club tennis and/or pickle ball members and their guests during the official tennis and pickle ball summer season, June 18, 2022 to Labour Day.

Tennis Membership

Tennis membership includes privileges of unlimited play, advance court booking, tournaments, clinics, and round robin play. A tennis membership list will be posted in the tennis hut and updated weekly to show active tennis and pickle ball memberships.

In order to play tennis or pickle ball at the Ojibway you must qualify in one of the following categories:

- An Ojibway Club member having purchased a tennis and/or pickle ball membership. Please refer to the tennis form on the Ojibway Club website for all membership categories and pricing.
- A guest of an Ojibway Club tennis member.
- A renter of an Ojibway Club cottage who pays tennis membership fees.
- A member of the Ojibway Club staff.

Guests

- Please note that all guests must be accompanied on court by the hosting tennis member.
- Guest fees are \$15/person for each court booking.
- Ojibway Club members who are non-tennis members may play once per month as a guest of a tennis member.

Ojibway Club Children & Staff

- Children (age 15 and younger) of OC tennis members may play tennis at no charge.
- Children (age 15 and younger) of OC members may join tennis for the season (special rate.)
- Ojibway Club staff may play tennis at no charge.

Booking Courts and Rules of Play

- Booking is a privilege of tennis membership and may be done online, in person at the main office, or by phoning the main office. Please note that members may have only three advance bookings in a 21 day period.
- Players can book up to an hour for singles and up to 1.5 hrs for doubles.
- If a member does not show up for a previously booked court, that member's account will be charged \$20.00.
- Booked courts must show the names of all players actively playing on that court. Using other members' names to hold a court, when a player has reached their maximum number of advance bookings, may result in suspension of booking privileges.

Tournaments

- Tennis members are welcome and encouraged to play in all tournaments.
- Guests are eligible to play in the Pewter Cup tournament only.

Off-Season Play

- All Ojibway Club members are eligible to play on the Ojibway Club courts prior to June 18th and post Labour Day.
- Guests are eligible to play in the off-season if accompanied by an Ojibway Club member.
