



Ojibway Club Racquets - Policies

General

Ojibway Racquets is an important aspect of the Ojibway Club. It operates on a budget that is dependent upon tennis and pickleball membership fees and programs revenues. Court maintenance and improvements are financed from tennis revenues. Playing privileges are extended to Ojibway Club Racquets members and their guests during the official tennis and pickleball summer season.

Racquets Membership

Membership includes privileges of unlimited play, advance court booking, tournaments, clinics, and round robin play. In order to become a Racquets member, you must qualify in one of the following categories:

- An Ojibway Club member in good standing.
- A renter of an Ojibway Club cottage.

Guest Policy

- Guests refer to:
 - Ojibway Club members who are not Racquets members (note: may play once per month as a guest of a tennis member).
 - House guests of an Ojibway Club Racquets member
- All guests must be accompanied on court by the hosting Racquets member.
- Guest fees are \$20 per guest per hour or \$30 per guest for 1 ½ hours.
- Guests may play a maximum of 4 times per season (ie. from the official Ojibway Club opening day through Labor Day).
- Guests may only play after 12:30PM. However, if at 8AM on the morning they would like to play, there are courts available before 12:30PM, a member may book a court with a guest.
- Guests may not sign up for clinics in advance. However, if by 8AM on the morning that the clinic is taking place there are openings, then guests may join a clinic. Guests attending clinics must be accompanied by a Racquets member (who must also be playing) AND they will be billed for clinic plus the guest fee.
- Guests may not sign up for round-robins.

Ojibway Club Children & Staff

- Children (age 15 and younger) of Racquets members may play at no charge.
- Children (age 15 and younger) of Racquets members may join for the season (special rate.)
- Ojibway Club staff may play at no charge.

Booking Courts and Rules of Play

- Booking is a privilege of Racquets membership and may be done online, in-person at the Ojibway Club office, or by phoning the Ojibway Club office. Please note that members may have only three advance bookings in a 7 day period.
- Players can book up to an hour for singles and up to 1.5 hrs for doubles.
- If a member does not show up for a booked court, that member's account will be charged \$20.00.
- Booked courts must show the names of all players actively playing on that court. Using other members' names to hold a court, when a player has reached their maximum number of advance bookings, may result in suspension of booking privileges.

Tournaments

- Racquets members are welcome and encouraged to play in all tournaments.
- Guests are eligible to play in the Pewter Cup tournament only.

Off-Season Play

- All Ojibway Club members are eligible to play on the Ojibway Club courts prior to June 18th and post Labour Day.
- Guests are eligible to play in the off-season if accompanied by an Ojibway Club member.
