REGION



Vino de la Tierra de Castilla, La Mancha, Spain: SPÑ comes from *La Mancha*, an elevated plain in the heart of Central Spain with an extremely hot, dry climate that naturally produces ripe, structured wines from the clay and limestone soils. Castilla La-Mancha is an autonomous community of Spain. Comprising of the provinces of Albacete, Ciudad Real, Cuanca, Guadalajara and Toledo, it was created in 1982, The government headquarters are in Toledo and its largest city is Albacete. The region largely occupies the southern half of the Iberian Peninsula's Inner Plateau, including large parts of the catchment areas of the Tagus, the Guadiana and the Jucar, while the northeastern relief comprises the Sistema Iberico mountain massif. It is bordered by Castile and Leon, Madrid, Aragon, Valencia, Murcia, Andalusia and Extremadura. It is one of the most sparsely populated of Spain's regions.

Castilla—La Mancha is the third largest of Spain's autonomous regions, representing 15.7 percent of Spain's national territory. Castilla—La Mancha has a continentalized Mediterranean climate; a Mediterranean climate but with more extreme temperatures typical of a continental climate. Lack of marine influence leads to more extreme temperatures: hotter summers and quite cold winters, with a daily oscillation of 33.3 °F. Summer is the driest season, with temperatures often exceeding 86 °F, sometimes reaching and exceeding 95 °F. In winter, temperatures often drop below 32 °F, producing frosts on clear nights, and occasional snow on cloudy nights.

Castilla—La Mancha is part of what has traditionally been called *España Seca* ("Dry Spain"). It receives relatively scarce precipitation, much as in a typical Mediterranean climate. Precipitation presents a notable gradient from the center of the region, where it does not surpass 400 millimeters (16 in) per year, to the mountains where it can exceed 1,000 millimeters (39 in) per year, on the slopes of the Sierra de Gredos and the Serrania de Cuenca. The greater part of the region has less than 600 millimeters (24 in) of rain annually.
