APPELLATION: Cabernet Sauvignon mostly from Lodi, with a little fruit coming from Lake County. Petite Sirah all coming from Lodi.

LODI, CALIFORNIA

Lodi is a city located in San Joaquin County, California, in the center portion of California's Central Valley. Lodi is best known for wine grape production, awarded the "2015 Wine Region of the Year" by *Wine Enthusiast* magazine. Lodi is flat terrain at an elevation of approximately 50 feet above mean sea level datum. Historically, land in the area has been used for grazing as well as for grain production.

Lodi has cool, wet winters, often characterized by dense ground fog, and hot, dry summers with a considerably higher degree of diurnal temperature variation than in winter. According to the Köppen climate classification system, Lodi has a hot-summer Mediterranean climate (Köppen Csa). Due to the city's proximity to the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta, summer temperatures usually dip into the fifties at night. Fog and low overcast sometimes drifts in from San Francisco Bay during the summer and it can be breezy at times, especially at night.

LAKE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

Lake County is a county located in the north central portion of the U.S. state of California. The county takes its name from Clear Lake and is directly north of the San Francisco Bay Area.

Lake County is part of California's Wine Country, which also includes Napa, Sonoma, and Mendocino counties. It includes five American Viticultural Areas and over 35 wineries.

Some vineyards were planted in the 1870s by European Americans but the first in the state were established in the 18th century by Spanish missionaries. By the early 20th century, the area was earning a reputation for producing some of the world's greatest wines.



After prohibition, the reemergence of Lake County's wine industry began in the 1960s when a few growers rediscovered the area's grape-growing potential and began planting vineyards. Several Lake County American Viticultural Areas, such as High Valley AVA and Red Hills Lake County AVA, have been recognized as having distinct character.

Lake County has a Mediterranean climate with hot summer daytime temperatures in its lower elevations. Night time temperatures remain cool year-round, somewhat moderating average temperatures and relieving the summer heat.

Jamey moved to Napa Valley from his home in South Carolina to manage Mustards Grill in 1996. Simply captivated by the community, lifestyle, and culture of wine country, he found himself quickly growing roots. By 1998, he had begun his winemaking education at Turley Wine Cellars where he would remain in his apprenticeship until 2005. During that time, he spent a summer sabbatical working for the Seysses family at Domaine Dujac in Morey-Saint-Denis and laid the groundwork for Whetstone Wine Cellars, which he founded in 2002. He is also the creator of another two brands —Noah River Wine & Spoken West.
