**A to Z Riesling**- Floral notes of honeysuckle, rose, and elderflower quickly rise along with lime, green tea, juniper, thyme, and marjoram. On the palate, a sense of fresh lime juiciness fills the mouth joined by lemon, papaya, lychee, pineapple, honey- dew melon, and peach as well as a light sweetness as of ginger and lemon meringue pie.



**Matanzas Creek Sauvignon Blanc**- Color: Pale straw

Aromas & Flavors: Elderberry flowers, lime zest, limestone, quartz, feijoa, and pink dragon fruit. Gentle salinity marries well with the enticing acidity to bring out the floral aromas, delivering a consistent finish. Serving Suggestions: Chill to 55-57°, pair with olives, raw oysters, cucumber melon salad, or Greek salad with feta.

**A to Z Pinot Noir** - The abundant red fruit profile including cherry, pomegranate and raspberry follows on the palate along with hints of leather, rose petals and citrus zest.

The oak is well-integrated, and the acidity is beautifully vibrant, with perfect balance on the mid-palate supported by moderate, smooth tannins and modest alcohol. A to Z Pinot Noir is fresh, juicy, and light on its feet.



**Silk & Spice Red Blend** - Intense, deep ruby color, with a bright red rim. The predominant flavors are ripe, cooked black fruits. Sweet notes of vanilla and hints of mocha. The first impression in the mouth is rich and full. Excellent balance of tannins and acidity, with a long, smooth finish.



**M Cabernet Sauvignon** - great farmers in top vineyard sites. We source from some of the most prestigious sites in Paso Robles' Adelaida, Estrella, El Pomar, Creston, and Geneseo Districts, including John Vineyards, Beato, Armory, Bootjack Ranch, Wilderness, and Lago Vineyards. Blackberry, chocolate-raspberry, espresso roast coffee, au jus, cardamom, cigar box, new leather, dense, youthful tannin, persistent finish.
