

Dusty Nabor Viognier J + K Vineyard

California, Santa Barbara County ~ The Dusty Nabor Viognier J+K Vineyard is probably our favorite expression of this grape variety we've tried from Dusty. It's classically floral but maintains a sense of richness and weight that adds a real layer of complexity that you might not expect. Decadent, complex, and yet still refreshing, this is a truly serious wine.

Bolt to Roussanne

\$34.99

100% Roussanne from Ballard Canyon, Santa Barbara. Dark golden hue bleeds into a light straw color in the glass. Driven by acidity, this wine, while varietally correct, is not as robust as some of our other Roussannes. More focused as the tropical fruits drive through the mid palate for a long, mineral finish.

Desert Wind Ruah Wahluke Slope \$19.99

Columbia Valley, WA- The wine is intensely aromatic, with Bing cherry, red currant, and toasted walnut in the forefront. On the palate, flavors of cherry, raspberry, and clove mingle harmoniously with supple tannins ending in a long finish. Pair with barbeque or roasted meats. Enjoy now or cellar 5-8 years.

Red Blend: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, and Cabernet Franc.

Walla Walla Vintners Merlot

This classic expression leads with juicy notes of red cherry and sun-ripened raspberry, while subtle hints of savory herbs add intrigue. We've woven in touches of Cabernet Sauvignon for mid-palate weight and Malbec for color and complexity. The result? A wine that's both generous and structured, with gently chalky tannins carrying the long, graceful finish.

NSO Wines Grenache

From Dusty Nabor's NSO Project ~ NSO stands for "no special occasion". This 100% Grenache is from Sta Rita Hills. Bright ruby color with good balance of acidity and tannins. Grenache is known for its intense fruity and herbal notes. It can have flavors of strawberries, black cherries, and raspberries, with hints of cinnamon and anise.
