by Ott is a wine produced with all the savoir-faire of the Domaines Ott team in the newly-constructed cellar of Château de Selle. It is a refined and elegant wine for any rosé enthusiast. The blends originate from select vineyards in Côtes de Provence that have been chosen to ensure that the wine is characterized by fruit and freshness with added finesse and complexity.



Schlumberger Gewurztraminer Les Princes Abbés \$34.99

100% Gewurztraminer

"The nose is frank, pleasant and intense. We can smell a dominant of exotic scents, citrus fruits, candied orange, grapefruit, pear, peach, mango, passion fruit. Airing amplifies these smells and reveals a floral note, rose and spices, ginger, curry. The range of aromas of the nose, always dominated by citrus fruits, grapefruit, candied orange, exotic fruits, peach, pear, passion fruit, mango, rose, spices, curry and ginger follow through on the palate." -Winemaker Notes

Chateau Lacapelle Cabanac Cahors Malbec \$19.99

80% Malbec, 20% Merlot | Producer: Thierry Simon & Philippe Vérax
There are two vineyards at Lacapelle Cabanac, one is entirely of "causse" – the name for the chalky ballasts coated with decalcified Kimmerigian clay unique to the plateau of Cahors. It features excellent drainage capabilities given its distance from the river. Yields are kept very low. The other vineyard is situated on a chalky limestone plateau at 300m altitude and benefits from the cooler climates of the Lot Valley. Large nocturnal/diurnal temp shifts result in late harvest.



Delas Frères Crozes-Hermitage 'Les Launes' Rhone Syrah \$34.99

Chateau Saint-Andre Corbin St. Georges St. Emilion \$24.99

"Fleshy and enticing, with juicy plum and red currant notes backed by sweet tobacco and a hint of singed cedar. A violet accent hangs in the background throughout. Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Drink now through 2031."
