Far Mountain "Myrna" Chardonnay 2021

The word **Myrna** translates to "beloved", a reflection of our feelings about truly great Chardonnay: wines that can translate from their sites intense minerality, texture and a dazzling spectrum of flavors.

Mineral-driven Chardonnay with orchard fruit and salty sea-air finish. Textured, hillside-vine fruit with flint, white pear and bright acidity.



E. Guigal Tavel 2023

60% Grenache, 15% Cinsault, 10% Clairette, 10% Syrah, 5% Other Varieties

Pure and deep salmon pink. The nose opens with elegant floral and fruit notes. The palate is fruit and well structured, with constant aromatic finesse. Overall, the wine is a pleasant balance between fleshy fruitiness, pleasant acidity, and body.

Bodegas Muga Reserva 2021

\$29.99

70% Tempranillo, 20% Garnacha, 10% Mazuelo and Graciano

Medium-high depth of color -- black-cherry red with garnet hues. First, red-fruit notes appear on the nose, with hints of fennel and scrubby heathland, balanced by smoky aromas. Underlying hints of vanilla come through with coffee notes.



Duluc de Branaire-Ducru 2018

56% Cabernet Sauvignon, 36% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot, 3% Cabernet Franc

"The color is intense and deep. The nose is expressive and complex, the nose blends fruity and spicy fragrances. Allowed to breathe, gourmet and refreshing notes are revealed which give the bouquet a tasty liveliness. A perfect expression of the beautiful maturity of this vintage, the mouth seduces with its roundness, its subtle acidity as well as its delicate spicy aromas resulting from the aging in wood. Persistent, the finish is beautifully fresh." -Winery Notes



Tommasi Ripasso 2021

\$29.99

Corvina 70%, Rondinella 25%, Corvinone 5%

A deep, bright ruby red in color, it is rich and intensely spicy on the nose, with notes of cherry jam, tobacco and black pepper. On the palate it is full-bodied yet elegant, with gentle, silky tannins and a very long finish.
