#### **Eyes of the River**

89% Carricante | 11% Grecanico

A love poem by the Sicilian drummer and musician Alfio Antico which describes the blue eyes of the beloved. The grapes are cultivated on the Etna Mountain. The wine is brilliant, clear straw yellow and the nose feels the aromatic complexity that sets this wine apart, with notes of intense floral and tropical fruit. In the mouth it is fresh, complex, with good sapidity (full-flavored).

Red Blend: Nero D'Avola & Syrah from Trapani municipality of Agro

It has a dense ruby red color with bright purple traces. The nose opens with fruity notes of morello cherry, forest fruits and plum, enriched with pleasant hints of rhubarb, cloves, licorice and tobacco leaves. On the palate it is full and enveloping with a good tannic texture and long persistence.

Red Blend: Nerello Mascalese and Nerello Cappuccio

An elegant, volcanic red with volcanic minerality, dark fruit (cherry, berry), spice, and earthy/ashy notes from its Nerello Mascalese/Cappuccio grapes, offering a balanced, fresh palate with firm tannins, a silky texture, and a long, savory finish. Showcases the unique terroir of Mount Etna. Drink now.



### **Al-Cantara Don Candeloro Etna Rosso 2019**

Primarily Nerello Mascalese, grown on volcanic soils.

*With less than 1,000 bottles made, this rare wine features 18-year-old Nerello Mascalese vines and an average yield of 70-80 quintals per hectare.*

The Al-Cantara Don Candeloro Etna Rosso 2019 is a highly-regarded Sicilian red from volcanic soil, known for its complex profile of red berries (cranberry, cherry), savory notes (iron, herbs, dried meat), minerality, and balance, featuring Nerello Mascalese grapes with tight tannins and bright acidity, making it a food-friendly, nuanced wine to drink now.
