### Eyrie Pinot Gris 2023

Highly regarded white wine from the Dundee Hills of Oregon, known for its elegant style, complexity, and ageability. The winery, founded by David Lett, was the first in America to plant the Pinot Gris grape commercially.

Comes from a 15-acre estate vineyard on Parrett Mountain in the Chehalem Mountains AVA, which features dark red Jory clay soils. The wine has a peppery nose of cranberry, orange rind, and ginger root, with flavors of cherry, raspberry, and hints of cola and dusty cinnamon on the palate.

Inviting notes of **Honeycrisp apple, raspberry, and tart cherry** dance with delicious baking spices of **cinnamon, cardamom, and anise**. It offers a beautifully balanced palate with a warm milk-chocolate finish. Rich and pleasing with lingering tannins.

### Patricia Green Estate Vineyard OV Pinot Noir 2022

The Estate Vineyard, Old Vine bottling is the flagship wine of Patricia Green Cellars. To some extent the 2022 vintage is the MOST Estate Old Vine Pinot Noir bottling ever as it literally spans the breadth of the site and includes what would essentially be "declassified" versions of those high-end, block designate bottlings. Expect all the good things this wine usually shows with a little extra gear to it.



### Ponzi Vineyards Laurelwood District Pinot Noir 2022

A highly-rated, sustainable wine from the northern Willamette Valley. This vintage reflects a year with a dry, warm October that allowed for perfect ripening. Initial notes of warm raspberry jam, chili pepper, and gunsmoke, opening to floral scents of rose petal, magnolia, and lavender. A complex mix of blue fruit (blueberry, blackberry), cola, white pepper, and spices like star anise and cardamom.
