It is known for its bright, straw-yellow color with light coppery hues, offering a complex, aromatic profile with notes of apricot, white peach, citrus, jasmine, and acacia flowers. The palate is typically described as structured, full-bodied, and, elegant with a fresh, mineral-driven finish.
