A refreshing Douro white with **bright fruit aromas, crisp acidity**, and a **slight mineral edge** — versatile for seafood, salads, and lighter fare.



Zacharias Lexis M Single Vineyard Red 2021

100% Mavrodaphne, indigenous Greek red variety

Single vineyard in Nemea, Peloponnese. A **dry, elegant expression of Mavrodaphne** that highlights both fruit and savory complexity. Herbal and spice elements add depth alongside the red and plum fruit profile.

Siegel Single Vineyard Los Lingues Petit Verdot 2019

100% Petit Verdot from the Los Lingues vineyard in Chile's Colchagua Valley.

A **structured, flavorful Petit Verdot** reflecting dark fruit concentration and spice complexity. Pairs well with **red meats** (e.g., lamb or grilled beef) and richer, savory dishes thanks to its tannin structure and depth of flavor.



Thorn-Clarke Shotfire Reserve Barossa Shiraz 2019

100% Shiraz (Syrah)

A **powerful yet polished Barossa Shiraz** showing rich fruit, oak influence, and structure that drinks well now and can cellar further. Full-bodied and **round with dense dark plum, blackberry and liquorice** flavors. **Silky, fleshy tannins** give structure without being overly aggressive.



Venge Vineyards Silencieux Napa Cabernet Sauvignon 2022

92% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc and 3% Merlot

Classic Bordeaux varieties are included to add complexity to the blend. Flavors include **charred caramel, mocha/roasted coffee, and hints of fresh herbs**, giving complexity and depth. Approachably enjoyable now but has the structure to age further with proper cellaring.
