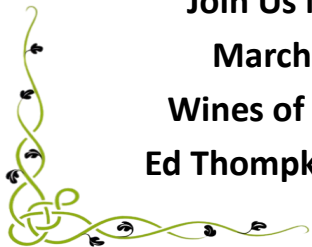

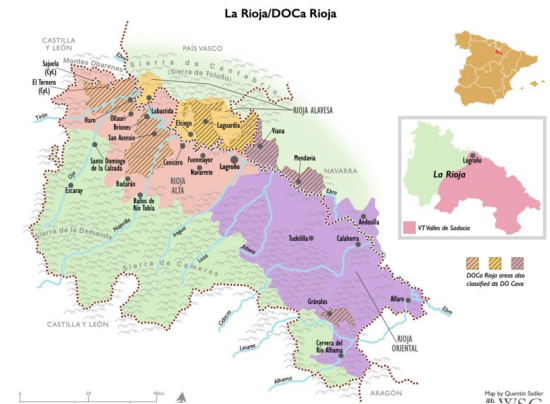


## Wines of Rioja, Spain with Tommy Kramarz, Euro Fine Wine

Euro Fine Wine's portfolio boasts many imported wines with special attention given to wines of Rioja, Spain. Explore this region with your tour guide, Tommy Kramarz, on Saturday. Rioja is one of the most classic wine regions to explore because its style is deeply shaped by climate, soil diversity, and a very distinctive winemaking tradition.

**Vinsacro** is a Rioja wine label from **Bodegas Escudero**, crafted from estate vineyards on the slopes of Monte Yerga using traditional blends of Tempranillo, Garnacha, and other native grapes grown in calcareous clay soils.

**Bodegas Luis Cañas** is a family-owned Rioja producer dating back to 1928, known for its high-altitude vineyards in Rioja Alavesa where old vines and low-yield, chalky-clay soils produce concentrated, elegant wines.

### Luis Canas Reserva Seleccion de la Familia 2019

*Widely admired by critics for its depth, balance, sophistication and aging potential. This is a serious, expressive Reserva that marries Intense dark fruit with spice and oak complexity, supported by firm tannins and a persistent finish — typical of a top-tier Rioja with excellent aging prospects.*



### Luis Canas Rioja Gran Reserva 2016

95% Tempranillo | 5% Graciano

*Deep ruby color with a bright garnet rim. The nose offers ripe dark cherries, blackberry, and plum, layered with cedar, vanilla, tobacco, and subtle spice from extended oak aging. On the palate, it is full-bodied and structured, with silky, integrated tannins, balanced acidity, and a long, persistent finish showing hints of leather and toasted oak.*
