Bright citrus-yellow; aromas of peach, nectarine, and jasmine. Fresh, mineral-driven palate with vibrant acidity and a clean, persistent finish.

60% Touriga Nacional, 25% Tinta Roriz, 15% Touriga Franca

Expressive nose of cassis, black cherry, and subtle spice. Medium-full with ripe tannins, dark fruit core, and a long, balanced finish.

Susana Esteban Aventura Tinto 2024

Typically a field blend of Alentejo varieties (often Aragonez/Trincadeira/Alicante Bouschet – varies by vintage)

Fresh and vibrant with red berries, wild herbs, and subtle spice. Light-to-medium body, soft tannins, and an easy, energetic finish.

Savannah Verdelho Special Reserve

92—94 Points Range

85% Verdelho & 15% blend of older Madeira wines used for complexity

Amber-hued with aromas of dried citrus, roasted nuts, and caramel. Medium-dry style with bright acidity, notes of orange peel and toffee, and a long, tangy finish.



Quinta do Noval 10 Year Old Tawny Port \$39.99

Traditional Douro field blend:

Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, others

Brick-amber color; layered aromas of dried fig, caramel, toasted nuts, and spice. Silky palate with balanced sweetness, oxidative complexity, and a long, nutty finish.
