Turley Wine Cellars was founded in Napa Valley by former emergency room physician Larry Turley in 1993. Under the direction of winemaker Tegan Passalacqua, Turley now makes 50 different wines from over 50 vineyards across California, primarily Zinfandel and Petite Syrah, with many vines dating back to the late 1800s. By farming organically and focusing on old vine vineyards of these varieties, Turley aims to both create and preserve California's unique winemaking culture.

Paso Robles Pesenti Vineyard 2023

100% Zinfandel (Certified organic vines planted in the 1920s)

Deeper and fuller-bodied, showing darker fruit and richer texture.

Dark plum, blackberry, cocoa, licorice, clove, and smoked pepper dominate this rich and expressive Paso Robles Zin. Medium-grained tannins and limestone-driven freshness provide balance and structure.



Contra Costa Del Barba Vineyard 2023

Primarily Zinfandel (typically near 100% bottling)

Quartz soils of the Sierra Nevada Mountains

Typically brighter and more aromatic with red fruit and spice notes.

Brambly red fruit, wild strawberry, pepper, and earthy spice with a lighter, lifted profile compared to richer Paso Robles bottlings. Old-vine character adds complexity and savory depth.



Buck Cobb Vineyard 2023

Vintages consistently receive 92-94 Points

Predominantly Zinfandel (small field-blend components)

Granite and Quartz soils of the Sierra Nevada Mountains

More concentrated and savory, often with deeper tannin structure.

Black cherry, blueberry compote, cracked pepper, dried herbs, and spice box aromas. Fuller-bodied with layered tannins and a long savory finish.



Howell Mountain Dragon Vineyard 2023

\$65.99

92 Points— Vinous

100% Zinfandel (2250 feet elevation, rocky red volcanic soil)

The most powerful and structured of the lineup, with mountain intensity, firm tannins, and long finish.

Red fruit, blood orange, chalk, mint, white pepper, and slate minerality. Firm tannins and vibrant acidity create a bold, age-worthy finish.
