

## Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

# **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty 3-1/2" squares

### From each of Fabrics B and C, cut:

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: eighty 3-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric D, cut:

four 4" x WOF strips. Subcut: forty 4" squares for the HSTs

#### From Fabric E, cut:

sixteen 4" x WOF strips. Subcut: one hundred sixty 4" squares for the HSTs

#### From Fabric F, cut:

twelve 4" x WOF strips. Subcut: one hundred twenty 4" squares for the HSTs

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)


**Step 1:** Pair a Fabric 4" Fabric E square with a 4" Fabric D square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make eighty D/E HSTs.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make two hundred forty E/F HSTs.




#### Assemble the Blocks



**Step 3:** Gather: one Fabric A square four Fabric B squares four Fabric C squares four D/E HSTs twelve E/F HSTs


Arrange the units into five rows of five. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.




**Step 4:** Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row.

**Step 5:** Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The Block will measure 15-1/2" square. Repeat to make twenty Blocks.



## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 6:** Arrange the blocks into five rows of four blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 7: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 8:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
