

# Blossom Baby Blanket

*This soft and cuddly blanket is easy to knit, and simple to re-size.*

## yarn

Trendsetter Blossom  
4 skeins #13/White  
or 300yds comparable worsted weight yarn

## needles & notions

Size 15 (10mm)

## gauge

9 stitches & 16 rows = 4" in garter stitch

## finished size

30" square; 44" diagonally from corner to corner



## instructions

Cast on 4 sts

Knit one row

Increase: K2, YO, knit to end

Repeat increase row until piece measures 22" from cast on (half of the total diagonal measurement), or until you reach end of second skein of yarn.

Decrease: K1, K2tog, YO, K2tog, knit to end

Repeat decrease row until 4 sts remain.

Knit 2 rows.

Bind off.

## re-sizing

When blanket reaches half of desired size, begin decrease row. Blanket may be knit with any yarn or needle size. This is a perfect project if you have a limited amount of yarn. Simply begin decrease row once half of the yarn has been used.

## abbreviations

K	Knit
K2tog	Knit two stitches together
st(s)	Stitch(es)
YO	Yarn over
