Supplies & Such

Supplies

- Fingering weight hand-dyed merino: 100gm skein (400 yards)
- Needles: size 3 (3.25mm) *or size to get gauge*
- Beads: 109 size 6/0 glass beads

Gauge

28 sts x 34 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

Finished Size

- 10" x 60", after blocking

Abbreviations

co	Cast on	wyif	With yarn in front
k	Knit	rsr	Right side row
k1b	Knit through the back loop	wsr	Wrong side row
p	Purl	ssk	Slip 2 sts knitwise, one at a time. Insert left needle into front of these 2 stitches from left to right, and knit these 2 stitches together.
st(s)	Stitch(es)	k2tog	Knit 2 stitches together
pb	Place bead	p2tog	Purl 2 stitches together
pm	Place marker	m1r	Insert left needle under strand that lies between the sts from back to front, knit into front of strand.
sm	Slip marker		
sl1	Slip stitch pwise with yarn in back		
sl3	Slip stitch pwise with yarn in front		
pwise	Purlwise		

Instructions

String 109 beads onto yarn. Place slip knot on needle with tail to front and strung beads to the back of needle. Cast on as follows:

*CO 3, pb, repeat from * until all 109 beads have been placed, CO 2 (329 sts)

Friiled Border

Row 1 p1, *k1b, p2; repeat from * until 1 st remains, k1b

Row 2 *p1, k1b, k1; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, k1, k1b

Repeat rows 1 & 2 twice

Row 7 *p1, k1b, drop next st off needle; repeat from * until 2 sts remain, p1, k1b (220 sts)

Row 8 *p1, k1b; repeat across

Row 9 Repeat row 8, do not turn, then using simple thumb method loosely CO 28 sts onto right needle

Make a lifeline by running a thin piece of contrasting yarn through the 220 border stitches, leaving the stitches on the needle. This will maintain the border stitches if it becomes necessary to unravel the body to correct any mistakes.

Body Edging

Row 1 (wsr)	p3, k23, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Row 2 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p23, k3
Row 3 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, k23, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Row 4 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p23, k3

Body Lace

Row 5 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p21, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Row 6 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p2, k3, *k1, yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo; repeat from * once, k3
Row 7 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p21, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Row 8 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p2, k3, *yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k1; repeat from * once, k3
Rows 9-36	repeat rows 5-8, seven more times
Row 37 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p20, pm, p1, pm, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Row 38 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p2, sm, m1r, k to next marker, sm, k2, *k1, yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo; repeat from * once, k3 (1 body stitch increased)
Row 39 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p to 2nd marker, sm, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Row 40 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p2, sm, k to next marker, sm, k2, *yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k1; repeat from * once, k3
Row 41 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p to 2nd marker, sm, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Rows 42-173	repeat rows 38-41, 33 more times (35 sts between markers)
Row 174 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p2, sm, k to next marker, sm, k2, *k1, yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo; repeat from * once, k3
Row 175 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p to 2nd marker, sm, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Row 176 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p2, sm, k to next marker, sm, k2, *yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k1; repeat from * once, k3
Row 177 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p to 2nd marker, sm, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Rows 178-269	repeat rows 174-177, 23 more times
Row 270 (rsr)	sl, k1, p2, sm, k to next marker, sm, k2, *k1, yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo; repeat from * once, k3
Row 271 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p to 2nd marker, sm, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Row 272 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p2, sm, ssk, k to next marker, sm, k2, *yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k1; repeat from * once, k3 (1 body stitch decreased)
Row 273 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p to 2nd marker, sm, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Rows 274-405	repeat rows 270-273, 33 more times
Remove stitch markers.	
Row 406 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p2, k3, *k1, yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo; repeat from * once, k3
Row 407 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p21, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Row 408 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p2, k3, *yo, k2, ssk, k2tog, k2, yo, k1; repeat from * once, k3
Row 409 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, p21, k2, p1, p2tog, turn (1 border stitch decreased)
Rows 412-437	repeat rows 406-409, seven more times

Body Edging

Row 438 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p23, k3
Row 439 (wsr)	sl3 pwise wyif, k23, p1, p2tog, turn (last border stitch decreased)
Row 440 (rsr)	sl1, k1, p23, k3
Bind off all sts in pattern. Completely unravel dropped border stitches, including the cast on.	
Block to measurement.
