

# Simple Brioche Scarf

*A quick-knit simple scarf worked in one-color brioche stitch.*

## *👄 yarn*

Rowan Big wool  
3 skeins #10/Midori  
or 260yds comparable bulky yarn

## *👄 needles & notions*

Size 13 (9mm)

## *👄 gauge*

8 stitches & 10 rows = 4" in brioche stitch

## *👄 finished size*

8" wide and 56" circumference



## *👄 instructions*

Cast on 19 stitches.

Set Up: K1 \*SL1YO, K1; repeat from \* to end  
Row 1: SL1WYIF, \*BRK, SL1YO; repeat from \* until 2 sts remain, BRK, SL1WYIF  
Row 2: K1, \*SL1YO, BRK; repeat from \* until 2 sts remains, SL1YO, K1

Repeat rows 1 & 2 until piece measures 56" or until approximately 6 yards of yarn remain ending with row 1.

Bind off in pattern, purling the SL1YO stitches with the yarn over omitted.

Seam beginning and ending edges together, forming scarf into a ring.

## *👄 abbreviations*

BRK	Knit the stitch that was slipped on the previous row together with its yarn over.
K	Knit
SL1YO	With yarn in front, slip the next stitch purlwise, then bring the yarn over the needle (and over the slipped stitch) and in position to work the following stitch. This slipped stitch/yarn over is considered one stitch.
SL1WYIF	Slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in front.
st(s)	Stitch(es)
