

Cabled Wreath

Greet your guests with this cozy cabled wreath, which brings a warm and inviting touch to any home.



yarn

MODE at Rowan Chunky Wool - 100gm/109yds (100m)
2 skeins 015/Vanilla

needles & notions

Size 10.75 (7mm) knitting needle
Size H (5mm) crochet hook
Cable needle
Tapestry needle

other supplies

16" styrofoam wreath

gauge

13 sts = 4" in stockinette stitch

abbreviations

C6B	Slip 3 sts purlwise to cable needle and hold to back, K3, K3 from cable needle
CH	Chain
K	Knit
P	Purl
RSR	Right side row
SlSt	Slip stitch
st(s)	Stitch(es)

instructions

Provisionally cast on 26 sts.

Row 1 (RSR)	K2, *P1, K6; repeat from * until 3 sts remain, P1, K2
Row 2	P2, *K1, P6; repeat from * until 3 sts remain, K1, P2
Row 3	K2, *P1, K6; repeat from * until 3 sts remain, P1, K2
Row 4	P2, *K1, P6; repeat from * until 3 sts remain, K1, P2
Row 5	K2, *P1, C6B; repeat from * until 3 sts remain, P1, K2
Row 6	P2, *K1, P6; repeat from * until 3 sts remain, K1, P2
Row 7	K2, *P1, K6; repeat from * until 3 sts remain, P1, K2
Row 8	P2, *K1, P6; repeat from * until 3 sts remain, K1, P2

Work rows 1-8 a total of twenty-two times, then work rows 1-7 once more. Do not bind off. (23 cable repeats total)

Place sts from provisional cast on onto empty needle, then graft together with ending stitches using kitchener stitch.

Work in ends and lightly block.

Finishing

Stretching piece around wreath as you work, seam edges with ladder (mattress) stitch.

Work ends into the inner seam of the wreath, then position knitted piece so that the seam is facing the backside.

With crochet hook, pull loop up at upper back seam. CH 8, SlSt in 1st ch, then fasten off. Work ends into the inner seam of the wreath.
